— MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT —



In Matthew 25:14-30, Christ describes believers as stewards—meant to oversee his possessions and his affairs.

The Stewardship Ministry at FBC is comprised of 6 members:
 Jared Vollman – Chair,
 Lana Wortham,
 Sharissa Negri,
 Kim Smylie,
 Shawna Uttenhove and
 Ty Etchemendy.

Their main task is reviewing requests from all FBC Ministries and creating a rough draft budget to present to the elders for each fiscal year. Additionally, a team of two meet once a week to count the tithes, deposit the funds and report the breakdown of those funds (general, benevolence, youth meals, bible study, etc.) to Amanda Panasuk – FBC bookkeeper.

The entire ministry along with Amanda meet monthly to review income and expenditures. They communicate with the various FBC ministries letting them know that their spending is in accordance with their budget or if they are approaching their limits. The Stewardship Ministry does not tell the other ministries how to spend their funds; they simply review those ministries annual budget request and help keep them keep on budget. The goal of the Stewardship Ministry is to have transparency in the checks and balances of your gifts.
